## PPE – Port Requirements

The Port requirements for PPE are explained below. Please ensure that this reaches all contractors and persons who access the Port site.

Operational Personnel - Anyone whose regular duties require them to be in the Port secure zone, rail terminal, bulk handling facilities or bulk minerals storage area.

**High visibility long sleeve shirt with retro-reflective strips**  
(AS4062:12011 Class N garment) any compliant colour is acceptable, however must be orange for rail workers

**Long pants with retro-reflective strips on the legs**  
(AS4062.1:2011 Class N garment)

**Safety Footwear**  
(Steel toe or composite)

**Safety Glasses**  
(AS1337.1.2010)

**Safety Helmet**  
(AS1801:1997 with retro reflective strips if working in hours of darkness)

**Gloves (task appropriate) are to be carried at all times**



This information is straight from MWPA Procedure 2.5 PPE.

There has been a notable number of recent breaches of these requirements. This standard has been in effect since June 2013. **Any persons not compliant with these requirements will be asked to leave site until they are wearing appropriate PPE. Repeat offenders may be refused access.**
