Shiploader 4 CV03/CV04 Project - Permits

During the SL04 and CV03/CV04 project, which will be undertaken between Monday, 17 October and Monday, 05 December 2016, Berth 4 will be deemed a 'construction site' and managed by MWPA Project Manager Shaun Knowles in conjunction with GCo – SL04 and Marine and Civil – CV03/CV04. As such, the site will be completely fenced off to delineate the 'construction site'. Any access to this site will be by a sign-in/sign-out process and will require a site-specific induction to be completed.

Ordinarily, this area is identified as part of the Bulk Handling Facility (Mine Site) under the Mines Safety and Inspection Act 1994 and Regulations 1995 when loading product specific under this Act. Normally, a BHF Authority to Work Permit is required for any works that are undertaken on this berth.

Please note that during the shutdown period (17 October to 05 December 2016) Form 4.1m BHF Authority to Work permit will NOT be required within the delineated 'construction site'.

While this berth is deemed a 'construction site', Western Australian Occupational Health and Safety Act 1984 and Regulations 1996 as well as the Port Authorities Act will be in force. Therefore any requirements for permits are to be submitted via the Midwest Ports Authority Permit email permits@midwestports.com.au and they will be processed in accordance with 4.1 Permit to Work Procedure.
